Overview

Trauma registries are an essential component of any trauma program. They are increasingly complex and require highly skilled and knowledgeable personnel.

The trauma registrar is the key to this success!



The Trauma Registrar Preceptor program is designed to work in conjunction with the Trauma Registrar Mentorship Program. The student is paired with a preceptor who has been oriented to your own hospital's EMR and trauma registry. The preceptor having established an IRR of 97% or higher with your hospital will then assume all training for the student.

This one on one training will optimize the students transition into their new role and have them functioning at an IRR 90% or greater level within 8 weeks.

The preceptor works with the student, assigns additional on demand lectures, exercises, and quizzes. Students will have an in-depth knowledge of the National Trauma Data Bank (NTDB) and Trauma Quality Improvement Program's (TQIP) data elements, and definitions. The students will be assigned actual hospital charts for abstraction, data entry, closure, and 100% data validation by the preceptor.

Our MISSION:

In keeping with our mission, this specially designed program is for 1 year!

- Hospital receives the BDVS Data Validation Software for 1 year
- Quarter 1: Initial 8 weeks intense training. After which the student should have an IRR of 90% or greater on all elements (excluding AIS) for patients with a 4 or less hospital LOS.
- Quarter 2: Student does independent work on LOS charts of 5-7 days. Preceptor will review and give feedback.
- Quarter 3: Student does independent work on LOS charts 8-10 days. Preceptor will review and give feedback
- Quarter 4: Student does independent work on LOS charts greater than 10 days. Preceptor will review and give feedback.
